Bylaw No. 4494, Oak Bay Official Community Plan Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2010

This amendment to the Official Community Plan is designed to comply with a new Local Government Act requirement that the Plan include targets for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, along with policies and actions proposed for achieving those targets.

Bylaw No. 4494 takes the provincial government's target of a 33% reduction by 2020 for British Columbia as a whole and extends it to the District of Oak Bay. Strategies are set out under the headings of Leadership, Emission Tracking, and Community Policies, Actions & Principles. As a statement of fundamental principles and philosophies, the Bylaw applies to all land within the Municipality.
